Veronica 'Blue Bomb'

- **Use:** Bright spikes of flowers will bloom all season long, right up until the first frost. Use in mass plantings or mixed with roses and perennials. Its compact shape is just right for containers. We find them to be an underappreciated workhorse of color in the garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to very light shade. Well-drained soil is key to successful culture.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-14" H x 12-14" W
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, narrow, dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Bearing upright wands of bright blue flowers, looking very Astilbe-like, for weeks on end, starting in early summer until winter frosts.
