Veronica longifolia 'Charlotte'

- **Use:** Narrow green leaves discreetly outlined in white reinforce the brilliant white spires of dainty flowers that continue to open throughout summer, adding a much-needed vertical presence to borders. Remove spent spikes to encourage a second, more compact flush. This distinctive new Speedwell shows good mildew resistance. Rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Any well drained soil in part sun will do. Full sun and leaves will turn more green. Dislikes extreme drought, but otherwise tough and versatile.
- **Growth:** The plants are trailing, 24" tall and 2 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial,
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; White edged foliage
- **Flower:** Striking, white, upright stems in dense clusters spring to fall.
