Viola wittrockiana

- **Use:** Pansies are the showstoppers of the winter garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. The smaller flowering violas are more shade tolerant. Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend the Pro Mix Soil. Require different fertilizer than most plants as they grow in the winter. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer with Nitrate not Ammonium nitrogen form of fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 6" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Perennial, but treated as an Annual as they are not attractive in the summer, but can survive with other plants shading them until fall when they will return.
- **Foliage:** Semi-Evergreen
- **Flower:** Many types to choose from! Blooms nonstop from October until April! More information from UGA on care on our website on the Plant Info page!
