

Delta Pansy flat



Viola wittrockiana 'Delta Series'

- **Use:** This series produces "faceless" colors of satiny richness held on short, flop-proof stems! Very tolerant of unseasonable heat and frosty chill. Pansies are the showstoppers of the winter garden, packed with weather-tough vigor.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend a peat based Soil. Require different fertilizer than most plants as they grow in the winter. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer with Nitrate not Ammonium nitrogen form of fertilizer for best results from December to March.
- **Growth:** The plants are just about 8 inches high and 8 to 10 inches wide, so they cover themselves with flowers.
- **Hardiness:** Perennial, but treated as an Annual as they are not attractive in the summer, but can survive with other plants shading them until fall when they will return. Reseed.
- **Foliage:** Semi-Evergreen; Green foliage.
- **Flower:** Delta brings you bright, clear varieties boasting extra-large, extra-early, extra-tough blooms. Blooms nonstop from October until April!
