

Wonderfall Trailing Pansy



**Non-stop flowers from
October until April.**

Viola 'Wonderfall Series'

- **Use:** With a true trailing habit, these pansies are ready to drape fetchingly from a hanging basket or brighten up your borders. The very well-branched, prostrate and spreading plants grow vigorously, producing medium-sized blooms that hold up in rain and weather better than larger-flowered types.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full to part sun. The smaller flowering violas are more shade tolerant. Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend the Promix peat soil. Require different fertilizer than most plants as they grow in the winter. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer with Nitrate not Ammonium nitrogen form of fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 6" tall and cascades over pots.
- **Hardiness:** Perennial, but treated as an Annual as they are not attractive in the summer, but can survive with other plants shading them until fall when they will return. May reseed.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; dainty foliage.
- **Flower:** The dainty 1 ½" flowers are edible, and welcome additions to a spring and summer salad. Bloom nonstop from fall until late spring/summer. More colors available than some other trailing pansy types.
