

Devil's Wine Calla Lily



Zantedeschia rehmanii 'Devil's Wine'

- **Use:** What may not be known about this plant is its adaptability. We have grown them successfully in a flower border along with other bulbs and perennials. The stems and the calyx are sturdy and long and therefore fit perfectly in bridal and exclusive bouquets. The average length is 60 to 70 cm and the vase life is at least two weeks. UPON PLANTING BE SURE NOT TO OVERWATER THEM FOR THE 1ST FEW MONTHS. ALLOW TO DRY OUT SLIGHTLY BETWEEN WATERINGS.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun or at least 5-6 hours of sun. However, we have also had success with them in full sun and fairly shady locations also if the soil is good. They hate red clay so don't think about getting this plant without amending the soil or putting them in a planter. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry allowing to dry out between waterings. Use slow release fertilizer for best results.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-30" tall.
- **Hardiness:** 7-10 perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Rich green leaves with white speckles.
- **Flower:** In mid summer will have deep wine red flowers.
