Zantedeschia 'Morning Sun'

- **Use:** Well known as a graceful cut flower especially in eloquent, large flower arrangements, what may not be known about this plant is its adaptability. We have grown them successfully in a flower border along with other bulbs and perennials.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun or at least 5-6 hours of sun. However, we have also had success with them in full sun and fairly shady locations also if the soil is good. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. **GOOD DRAINAGE IS A MUST! WILL NOT TOLERATE RED CLAY!** If in doubt it is better to underwater them than to overwater them.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-30" tall.
- **Hardiness:** 7-10 perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The plants have heavily speckled leaves with an upright habit making them look very stately in the centre of a container on the patio.
- **Flower:** Zantedeschia Morning Sun has the most intense orange/red sun rise colour we have seen yet in a Zantedeschia. The flower stems are strong with a good sized vibrant flower that stands nicely above the leaves. Morning Sun is a slightly taller variety but is still suitable for growing in containers.
