- <u>Use:</u> This rain lily blooms beginning in June and continue on and off past September. This is a plant that asks for little, delivers dependably and should grace every warm weather garden.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun to partial shade, some shade is appreciated in hottest areas. Grows in most soils, but amend red clay. Drought tolerant!
- *Growth:* Grows 10-12" tall and spreads by small bulbs.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7-10; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Semi-evergreen. The dark green grassy foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Blooms summer to fall! Produces large, clear pink blossoms that pop open on foot-tall stalks that rise from slim, deep green foliage.

Lovely starry blossoms, easy care, tough constitutions and inexpensive - rain lilies are hard not to love.
