Abelias are great to use in beds, or as accents in the landscape, and container gardens.



Abelia x grandiflora 'Wevol'

- **Use:** This compact abelia has striking variegated foliage and profuse white flowers in late spring. It keeps a low profile with distinctive prostrate growth habit. A winner in small yards and containers. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** The mounded, and tightly-branched shrub remains small, with a height of 2-3 feet tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6 -9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. White and green variegated foliage
- **Flower:** Produces a heavy bloom of light white flowers from spring-summer.
