

Twist of Orange Abelia



Abelias are great to use in beds, or as accents in the landscape, and container gardens.



***Abelia x grandiflora* 'Twist of Orange' / 'Gretoo'**

- **Use:** A great shrub with green, gold, orange and red multi-color leaves. Produces clusters of white flowers through the summer and fall, adding an opulent glow to any corner of the landscape. A moderate grower reaching 4 to 5 feet tall and wide. Excellent for mass plantings. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** The mounded, and tightly-branched shrub remains small, with a height of 4-5 feet tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6 -9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Green, gold and red tinged foliage.
- **Flower:** Produces a heavy bloom of white flowers for a long period of summer and fall.
