

# Sunshine Daydream Abelia



## *Abelia x grandiflora* 'Abelops'

- **Use:** A kaleidoscopic combination of green, golden yellow, and dusty rose leaves will continually change with the seasons. Neater and more compact than any other Abelia cultivar. Produces white trumpet shaped flowers in spring maturing to pink. Would make a perfect foundation plant. Beautiful landscape specimen. Attracts Butterflies, Hot Dry site tolerant, Deer Resistant
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2 to 3 feet tall, 4-6 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Awesome tricolor variegation of pink, golden yellow and green
- **Flower:** White trumpet-like flowers emerge in Spring eventually turn pink-rose color.
