

# Amy Azalea



Azaleas work well massed or as specimens in woodland gardens, mixed borders, foundation plantings, and containers.

## *Azalea 'Amy' (Dodd hybrid)*

- **Use:** Perfect as a large growing hedge or in a shady spot in the landscape. It works well in many garden settings including woodland plantings, mixed borders, and as a specimen.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefer part shade generally. We don't recommend full sun unless you have fantastic soil and irrigation. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Plant matures at 4' to 5'
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 7 -9** Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen
- **Flower:** Semi-double flowers with rich pink petals fading to very pale pink toward the center.
