Azalea 'Dorothy Hayden'

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. A Robin Hill hybrid, this late-season bloomer produces single white flowers with a green throat in mid-spring on a low mounding shrub.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Mounding growth to a height of 2-3' tall and 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Small evergreen leaves.
- **Flower:** Pure white single flowers.
