## ***Azalea 'Duc de Rohan' (Southern indica)***

- **Use:** A heat-tolerant Southern Indica Hybrid, this evergreen azalea bears showy clusters of salmon-pink flowers in late spring and fall. Outstanding early to midseason azalea with single blooms of salmon-pink and excellent evergreen foliage. Useful as screen, hedge or bright, showy landscape accent.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade to sun (will need regular irrigation to establish). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Compact rounded growth habit only reaching two to three feet in height and width, but may grow larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Large medium green leaves.
- **Flower:** Large salmon flowers with a rose throat in late spring and again in fall.
