

# Azalea Fashion



**Orange-red flowers are real show-stoppers!**

## ***Azalea 'Fashion' (Glenn Dale type)***

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. A vivid red azalea should be prominent in foundation planting, particularly the front yard where it makes a big color splash from the street. Also works very well beneath tree groves in a naturalistic woodland setting. Problem solver for homes influenced by large old shade or street trees because azaleas thrive in the half shade and acidic soils they create.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Vigorous, upright grower to 2 to 4 ft. tall and wide. Makes a lovely accent, border or hedge.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; small dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Medium sized fiery orange-red flowers from April - May.
