Azalea 'Formosa'

- **Use:** This tall growing Southern indica variety azalea blooms early-mid season (April-May).
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Upright growth to a height of 6 to 12 feet tall and 6-8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Large evergreen leaves.
- **Flower:** Large purple blossoms are 2-3" wide.
