Azalea 'George Taber'

- **Use:** This tall growing Southern indica variety azalea blooms early-mid season. Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. Blooms late March-April.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 6 to 8 ft. tall, 4 to 6 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Large evergreen leaves.
- **Flower:** Produces masses of large, showy single blooms, light orchid variegated with white.
