

# Azalea 'Girard Christina'



**Clear rose-red

***Azalea 'Christina' (Girard type— very cold hardy)***

- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Takes on a broad, dense growing habit. Moderate grower to 2 to 4 ft. tall, 3 to 5 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, shrub
- **Foliage:** Glossy deep green and holds well.
- **Flower:** Flowers are large hose in hose 2.5-3" and a clear rose-red. Pleasingly ruffled and very floriferous. Mid-spring, March through April.
