

# Azalea Girard Hot Shot



**Good for use in flower beds. Orange red blossoms.**

## ***Azalea 'Girard Hot Shot'***

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. Blooms late March through April.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2 to 3 feet tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Tiny evergreen foliage on a low spreading form. It's habit is dense and compact with green foliage turning to orange-red in the fall.

- **Flower:** The large, 3" ruffled orangy-red flowers cover this plant in mid May!
