## *Azalea 'Girard' Pleasant'*

- **Use:** This Girard type is very strong and great for use as a hedge, specimen, or under story plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Prefers slightly acidic (4.5-6.5 pH) and well-drained soil, yet most soils in our area are already acidic.
- **Growth:** Takes on a broad, dense growing habit. Moderate grower to 3 to 4 ft. tall, 3 to 4 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Glossy deep green and holds well.
- **Flower:** Produces a brilliant display of compact white flowers in spring.
