Azalea 'Hallie' (Aromi type)

- **Use:** It works well in many garden settings including woodland plantings, mixed borders, and containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Must amend red clay
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3-5 tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Medium-sized elliptic mid-green leaves.
- **Flower:** Bears showy clusters of large purple-pink flowers in early to mid-spring. The ruffled unmarked flowers are hose-in-hose (with "stacked" whorls of petals)
