Azalea 'Irish Cream' (Holly Springs type)

- **Use:** Perfect as a low growing hedge or in a shady spot in the landscape. It works well in many garden settings including woodland plantings, mixed borders, and containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Please amend the soil if you have red clay.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3 to 4 ft. tall and 2 to 4ft. wide. Wide spreader.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Green leaves.
- **Flower:** The flowers are white and very large (in the 3" to 4" range) in mid-spring. Each flower has a greenish yellow blotch in the throat.
