## *Azalea 'King's White' (Belgian indica)*

- **Use:** This tall growing indica variety azalea blooms early-mid season (April-May). Makes a nice screen in the shade or for a woodland garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade, have seen it tolerate more sun once established if care is taken to keep properly watered. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Upright growth to a height of 6 to 8 feet tall and 6-8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Large evergreen leaves.
- **Flower:** Clusters of large, white blossoms are 2-3" wide.
