

# 1 gal Lilacina Azalea



This is a front of the border azalea because of its lower height. Perfect for the smaller garden.

## *Azalea 'Lilacina' / Lilacinum (S indica or mucronatum)*

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade preferred, but will tolerate more sun after established. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Large grower to 3 to 4 feet tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Even the leaves are notably smaller, making it the wonderful bonsai plant that it was originally bred to be.
- **Flower:** Open soft lavender blooms that look almost like small lillies.
