

Azalea Red Formosa



Good for use in flower beds. Fast growing! Reddish-purple blossoms.

Azalea 'Red Formosa' (Southern Indian or Indica)

- **Use:** These Azaleas have an upright growth habit and are the best choice for a high light area. Makes a nice screen in the shade or for a woodland garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part shade. May tolerate more light, but will need to be on an irrigation system and receive regular watering. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Upright growth to a height of 6 to 8 feet tall and 6-8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Large evergreen leaves.
- **Flower:** Blooms reddish-purple single 3 inch diameter flowers during the spring.
