Azalea 'Watchet' (Robin Hill Hybrid)

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. This is a cross between 'Amagasa' x ('Louise Gable' x Tama-giku'), these are compact and evergreen and produce masses of ruffled blooms in the spring and fall. The Robin Hill hybrids are a large group of Azaleas that got their start more than 50 years ago by Robert Gartrell of Wycoff, New Jersey.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Semi-dwarf grower to 2 to 3 ft. tall and 3 to 4 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark green foliage on a low spreading form.
- **Flower:** A rebloomer with profuse light pink flowers with ruffled petals.
