

# Nanho Blue Butterfly Bush



Long-blooming shrub and very easy to grow!



## ***Buddleia 'Nanho Blue'***

- **Use:** Lightly scented, Buddleias attract butterflies (and hummingbirds) like a magnet. 'Nanho Blue' branches support lilac-like clusters of flowers. Also a vigorous, long lasting cut flower. Tiny individual flowers are produced in profusion in long, dense trusses. In cooler zones, Buddleias die back to the ground each year, sending up a dense group of new shoots in late spring that quickly develop into a large shrub.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Cut faded flowers off a butterfly bush regularly to keep it blooming throughout the summer. Butterfly bushes prefer full sun (they must receive eight or more hours of sun a day to thrive)
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 5 to 7 feet tall and 4 to 6 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6 -9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small slightly furry leaves can have a silvery hue.
- **Flower:** Nonstop flowers spikes of brilliant blue from April – October.
