

Lo & Behold Lilac Chip Butterfly Bush



Buddleia x 'Lo & Behold Lilac Chip'

- **Use:** From the breeding work of NCSU's Dr. Dennis Werner. It is a complex hybrid containing *Buddleia davidii*, *Buddleia lindleyana*, *Buddleia globosa*, and *Buddleia fallowiana*, tops out at only 18" tall x 30" wide in two years. The compact clumps are adorned with panicles of fragrant lilac flowers all summer...great for low-flying butterflies!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Cold, wet winters can be really hard on buddleia, so here are a few tips to help your buddleia thrive in your garden: 1. Make sure the soil is well-drained. That place where water stands? Not a good idea. 2. Full sun. That's at least 6 hours. No cheating. 3. Wait until it leafs out in spring before pruning. In some years you may have to prune it back to the ground. After milder winters, maybe not so much. Avoid fall pruning.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 18-24" tall and 30" wide. Deadhead often for best reblooming.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Silvery green foliage.
- **Flower:** Lilac flowers are fragrant and attract butterflies. Reblooms until frost.

A good groundcover for mass plantings; perennial gardens; mixed borders. Non-invasive.
