

Wine Spritzer Beautyberry



Callicarpa dichotoma 'Shiji Murasaki'

- **Use:** Has striking variegated foliage that is highlighted by the red stems. Wine Spritzer™ Beautyberry produces lavender blooms in the summer followed by bright purple berries in the fall. Flowers and berries are attractive to wildlife. This moderate to vigorous growing shrub matures at 6 feet tall and is perfect for mass plantings or screens. Shrub size can be controlled with yearly pruning in late winter or early spring. Use it in semi-shade under tall pines. Deer resistant, Drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun or shade, but light shade is best for berry set. ; moist soil; prefers ample water in hot dry locations.
- **Growth:** Grows 4' tall and 6' wide. If overgrown prune to 6-18" tall; will regain height in one season.
- **Hardiness:** 6-10, shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; It has colorful variegated leaves that are white with green and cream splashes and pink petioles. The leaves will be more colorful if grown in full sun but light shade will help with drought resistance.
- **Flower:** Clusters (cymes) of small, pink to lavender flowers bloom in the leaf axils along the stems in summer.
- **Fruit:** Purple berries from September until March. Best cross-pollination and resultant fruit production occur when shrubs are planted in groups or massed.
