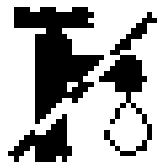


# Carolina Allspice/ Sweetshrub



## *Calycanthus floridus*

- **Use:** This deciduous shrub has a dense, rounded habit. Its unusual, waterlily-like, fragrant flowers combine the scent of strawberries, banana, and pineapple. The dark green leaves and bark release a clove or camphor-like scent when crushed. Deer resistant, Drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun or shade. Highly adaptable to many soil types and grows in sun or shade, though it blooms more when grown in full sun. Native from Virginia to Florida.
- **Growth:** 6' -10'tall and 6' -10' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-10, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Glossy, aromatic, leathery, dark-green foliage.
- **Flower:** Flowers appear in May and continuing blooming on and off into June and July.
