Camellia japonica 'Bessie Battle'

- **Use:** Abundant large blooms, white in color, make a delightful contrast with glossy, dark green evergreen leaves. A must have for every Southern garden to add winter interest.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Low growing to 3 to 4ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, glossy.
- **Flower:** Large double white blooms December to March. Prune only right after blooms fade.
