Camellia japonica 'Debutante'

- **Use:** Abundant large blooms, light pink in color, make a delightful contrast with glossy, dark green evergreen leaves. A valued plant in the milder regions of the U.S. One of the earliest to bloom.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, glossy.
- **Flower:** Large double pink blooms September to November. Prune only right after blooms fade.
