## *Camellia japonica* 'Dr Tinsley'

- **Use:** More like a wild rose than a camellia. This medium sized charmer rings many changes pale pink. The buds are brilliant pink in color and open to semi double blooms of soft pink with deeper shaded edges and occasional petaloids. It is recommended for the cooler climate where it flowers profusely in mid-season.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 10 to 12 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, glossy.
- **Flower:** Large semi double soft pink blooms September to November. Prune only right after blooms fade.
