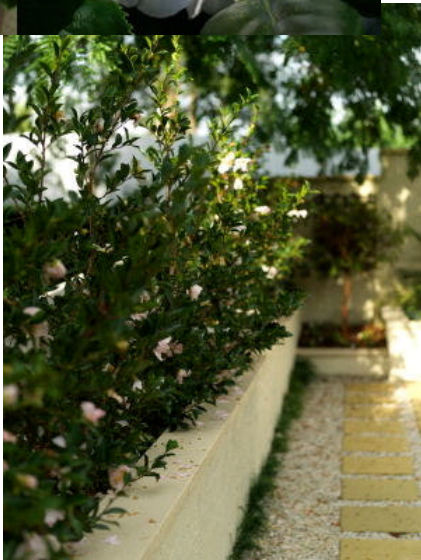


# Camellia 'Lady Vansittart'



Tolerates heat  
and humidity  
well!  
Deer resistant.



## *Camellia japonica* 'Lady Vansittart'

- **Use:** Moderate-slow growing evergreen shrub with wavy-edged glossy dark green leaves. A must have for every Southern garden to add winter interest. Also makes an excellent hedge.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Low growing to 8ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, glossy.
- **Flower:** Medium sized, semi-double white flowers irregularly striped rose- pink. Sometimes produces flower sports with white margined, pink petals, streaked deeper pink. Prune only right after blooms fade.
