Camellia japonica 'Morning Glow'

- **Use:** A vigorous, spreading camellia with white, formal flowers, Morning Glow is as lovely as its name. Introduced in 1948, this stately plant produces a heavy bud set and then blooms early and long. Morning Glow fits that bill for creating great winter interest in your garden.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- **Flower:** Admired for its pure white, formal double blooms from December through March. Prune only right after blooms fade.
