Camellia japonica 'Salmon Pink'

- **Use:** These gorgeous blossoms are the centerpiece of any spring garden! Camellias fit the bill for creating great winter interest in your garden. Deer resistant
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade form afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- **Flower:** Admired for its salmon pink, formal double blooms from December through March. Prune only right after blooms fade.
