

Bella Rouge Camellia



Small size makes it good for planters. Tolerates heat and humidity well!



***Camellia sasanqua* 'Bella Rouge'**

- **Use:** Bella Rouge's very compact growth habit is perfect for small spaces. Its red semi-double blooms appear in November through December. Every southern garden must include a winter showy camellia. An ideal beginner's plant, the easy-care camellia is covered year-round with broad and glossy toothed leaves.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, part sunny or medium shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 4-5' tall and 4-5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, Glossy green leaves.
- **Flower:** Stunning semi-double red flowers give us a Camellia that is perfect for planting in smaller spaces and adding brilliant color to the garden during the fall season. Flowers start appearing in early fall and continue into winter in our gardens. Prune only right after blooms fade as they set flowers 9 month in advance of blooming.
