**Tolerates heat
and humidity well!**

Camellia sasanqua 'Diana'

- **Use:** Every southern garden must include a winter showy camellia. An ideal beginner's plant, the easy-care camellia is covered year-round with broad and glossy toothed leaves.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, part sunny or medium shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 8-10' tall and 6-8' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, glossy.
- **Flower:** Brilliant white blooms make the Diana Camellia fit any garden color scheme. Blooms in October to November. Prune only right after blooms fade.
