

# Camellia 'Hot Flash'



This Camellia grows with the spreading style of Shishi Gashira, but dazzles the observer with bright red-rose flowers in the fall. It boasts dark green foliage year-round.



## *Camellia sasanqua* 'Hot Flash'

- **Use:** Camellias are used as specimen large shrubs, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder winter months when other plants are dormant.
- **Exposure:** Partial shade's preferred, but tolerates sun with ample water, evenly moist, humus-rich; high in organic matter, acidic, well-drained (porous) soils, protection from cold, drying winter winds, ample moisture, mulch layer. In full sun you will get leaf burn in late summer, but have great flower set.
- **Growth:** This vigorous grower matures at 4 to 5 feet tall and 6 to 8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Flowers are a rose-red, in great profusion over a long period in the winter.
