Create a wall of gorgeous winter blooming flowers with this trellis camellia.



Camellia sasanqua 'Magic Snow'

- **Use:** Small flowers appear in great profusion in fall on this compact conical camellia. Camellias are used as fall-winter specimen shrubs, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder fall-winter months when other plants are dormant.
- **Exposure:** Morning shade preferred (prevents frost damage to flowers), but tolerates sun with ample water, evenly moist, humus-rich; high in organic matter, acidic, well-drained (porous) soils, protection from cold, drying winter winds, ample moisture, mulch layer.
- **Growth:** Grows 5-6' tall by 5-6' wide dense growth. Can easily be pruned after blooming to keep them shorter.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Fully double white blooms appear as pom-poms with an extra layer of petals. A fine line of rose pink dusting complements each bloom.
