- <u>Exposure</u>: Partial shade's preferred, but tolerates sun with ample water, evenly moist, humus-rich; high in organic matter, acidic, well-drained (porous) soils, protection from cold, drying winter winds, ample moisture, mulch layer.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 24" 30" or more tall x 18" wide. Very compact, upright and dense growth.
- Hardiness: 6-9; shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Flowers are a clear medium pink, 3.5" diameter in great profusion over a long period.
