

Camellia Kagirohi Yellow



**Unusual soft yellow flowers.
Tolerates heat and humidity well!**



Camellia japonica 'Kagirohi'

- **Use:** A formal double yellow flowered Camellia bred by Kazuo Yoshikawa. This double-flowering camellia's extraordinary color, richer than rich yellow, is like an elixir of sunlight. Large creamy-yellow anemone-like flowers with deep yellow centers contrast magnificently with the sleek evergreen foliage.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade. Best in moist, acidic, organically amended, well-drained soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and 5' wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for glossy green foliage.
- **Flower:** Spherical buds open to display a medium sized pale yellow flower very late in the season. Prune only right after blooms fade.
