- **Use:** Sure to brighten up your landscape, the Golden Dragon Plum Yew is an elegant evergreen plant with a low and spreading vase-like habit and attractive arching branches covered with glossy, flattened, bright golden yellow needles that provide very unique and outstanding texture and color in the landscape. Ideal for use as an accent, in groupings or mass plantings, or as a border along walkways and in sunny to partially shaded landscape borders and home foundation plantings. It is an excellent choice for an evergreen groundcover under the canopies of large trees that are limbed up enough to allow some direct sun. Looks very nice around garden ponds or in rock gardens near boulders. Also suitable as a solo or combined with other plants in pots, planters and other containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun (but would need lots of irrigation and may burn in hottest summers) to shade; Part shade is ideal. Prefers moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and 4-5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Awesome gold needles when given enough sun. It grows well in complete shade, but it will be basically green.
- **Flower:** Insignificant flowers.
