

Upright Plum Yew



Cephalotaxus harringtonia 'Fatsigiata'

- **Use:** Used for evergreen hedges or borders, good for use at the corner of the home. Its symmetrical shape delivers a bold statement in formal groupings while equally effective as a foundation or specimen plant. Ideally suited for southern gardens, this cultivar was selected for its carefree, vertical growth habit. Exceptional shiny, dark green blunted needles. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Both heat and shade tolerant, it will thrive in morning sun with afternoon shade. Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Feed with a general purpose fertilizer before new growth begins in spring. For a tidy, neat appearance, shear annually to shape. Drought tolerant once established.

Growth: Grows 10' tall and 6-8' wide slow to moderately.

- **Hardiness:** 6 -9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Fern-like foliage.
- **Flower:** Insignificant flowers.

This elegant shrub is much sought after for its graceful foliage and is excellent for a hedge that requires little maintenance.
