## *Cryptomeria japonica* 'Yoshino'

- **Use:** Provides a tall, dense, evergreen screen or graceful specimen for the landscape. Lends textural and color contrast to the landscape. The summer needle color is glistening blue-green and growth rate is fast. It provides a shade-tolerant alternative to leyland cypress when used for screening purposes in the landscape.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Will grow and prosper in either sun or shade. Well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** This tall, stately conifer will reach 20 to 30 feet in height with a spread of 5 to 6 feet.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. During winter the foliage will develop a bronzy-purple winter hue, especially when exposed to cold winds.
