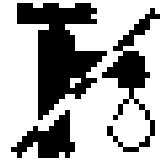


Japanese Cedar



A great substitute for Leyland Cypress with more disease resistance!



Cryptomeria radicans

- **Use:** Few trees have the majestic look or easy care of this splendid Japanese Cedar. It forms a tall, slender, wonderfully dense evergreen that offers year-round beauty as a privacy screen or specimen! And although it's an evergreen, this Conifer turns a rich bronzy-purple in winter -- a nice change of pace for the garden!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun /part shade; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Somewhat drought tolerant.
- **Growth:** Reaching 40 to 45 feet high but just 20 feet wide, this tree displays an elegant silhouette. It is a quick grower, reaching 12 to 16 feet tall within 5 years of planting.
- **Hardiness:** 5b-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** The foliage is exceptionally dense on this tree. Dark green and feathery, it offers good contrast to blue-leafed evergreens.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
