

Spring Frost Evergreen Witch Hazel



Distylium 'Spring Frost'

- **Use:** A new evergreen introduction that boasts new foliage growth with a frosty white coloration. An excellent spreading evergreen shrub with unique foliage which emerges golden white with red highlights on the margins. The color holds well into the summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows in full to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will tolerate wet soil.
- **Growth:** Grows 3' tall and 4' wide with layered branches are held in graceful, arching sweeps.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10 ; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; New growth starts out at its brightest, and then slowly turns to a blotched green & white pattern.....eventually maturing to a nice light to medium green. Occasional white spots or patches will exist well into foliage maturity.
- **Flower:** Small reddish / maroon flowers begin to appear in late winter, lasting for several weeks.



They are an outstanding alternative to commonly used species such as cherry laurels, junipers, hollies, Indian hawthorn, and even boxwood.
