- Use: From its wonderfully fragrant spring blooms to its neon-bright fall foliage, 'Mount Airy' is a delightful shrub that keeps your garden colorful 3 seasons a year and is as easy as pie to grow! The perfect size for a foundation planting, hedge, or accent, this vigorous shrub is one of the most beautiful investments you can make in your year-round landscape! Versatile and ever-changing, this is a shrub you simply must have!
- Exposure/Soil: Prefers full sun to part sun. Thrives in acidic soil amended with hummus or peat. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Reaching 4 to 5 feet tall and 3 to 4 feet wide, it is just the right size for a variety of garden uses.
- *Hardiness:* 5- 9 shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous, Small neatly veined leaves. Then, when the first chill of fall enters the air, the foliage turns ultra-bright shades of golden and orange! Wow!
- Flower: The show begins in spring, when dainty white blooms (about an inch across) appear, sporting a marvelous honey scent and bright, cheery look.
