Gardenia jasminoides 'Fool Proof'

- **Use:** Creating fragrant gardens is simple with this compact, upright, easy-to-grow gardenia. Double, pure white, fragrant blooms emerge in late spring and rebloom through fall. They adapt to a variety of soil conditions... do great in partial shade... and resist insects and disease. Even deer leave them alone. They're just as beautiful as they are tough. You get huge, velvety white flowers that bloom in pairs.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun (only with good irrigation system)/part sun preferred; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly when top 3in of soil is dry. Must amend the soil if you have red clay! We recommend our promix with **coconut peat soil mix**.
- **Growth:** Moderate, spreading grower to 3-4 feet tall, 3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Glossy green and white leaves, evergreen.
- **Flowers:** ***Double, pure white, fragrant blooms emerge in late spring and rebloom through fall.***
