

Red Yucca



Hesperaloe parviflora

- **Use:** It is not a true Yucca although it does look very similar to Yucca, and can be used in the landscape in the same ways. Recommended by UGA for its low maintenance qualities. Deer resistant. Attracts hummingbirds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; well drained, light soil; dislikes wet sites. Water occasionally in drought.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2 to 3 feet tall,.
- **Hardiness:** 6b -9 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, thick sword shaped recurved gray-green foliage.
- **Flower:** Bloom from April to November can reach up to 5 feet tall.
